### BYLAW NO. 04/04


#### A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Village of Lang in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression "municipality" shall mean the Village of Lang.
2. Subject to section 3, no person shall discharge any gun or other firearm, air-gun or spring gun or any class or type thereof within the municipality
3. The provisions of section 2 do not apply to a person who is:
  - a) a police officer;
  - b) a municipality appointed pest control officer or his/her assistants
  - c) a registered member of a gun club or similar organization while engaged in target practice at a recognized range
4. The Clerk/Administrator of the Municipality is hereby authorized to issue a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization who makes application for such permit stating specifically the intent of such club or organization and the location of their range.
5. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary condition shall be liable to a penalty as per bylaw 4/98.
