BYLAW NO. 2 - 90

A Bylaw to Provide For Entering Into An Agreement Respecting The Provision of Fire Protection Services

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Scott No. 98, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Scott No. 98 is hereby authorized to enter into the agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as Exhibit A, with the following municipality:

fire protection services.

Memorandum of Agreement made this 12th day of June 1990, A.D. Between: The Village of Lang

and

The Rural Municipality of Scott No. 98
This agreement Witnesseth as follows:

1. That the Village agrees to provide fire protection services throughout the "designated area" and that all residents residing within the designated area are protected under this agreement.

In this agreement the designated area includes:

- (1) All of the Village of Lang
- (2) All of the Rural Municipality of Scott No. 98
- 2. The Village of Lang will take their fire engine to the municipalities when the need arises. This protection is for paid up members who pay \$20.00 per year, and a fee for non members of \$300.00 per hour.

Description of the Lang fire fighting equipment made available under the agreement:

- (1) 'Superior' Triple Combination Pumper Front Mount Class "A" Front Proof Pump Assembled on a Ford Cab and Chassis. "A" 500 gallon full Fibreglass Booster Tank.
- (2) A stand by unit.
- 3. The Village of Lang owns, maintains, stores and is responsible for dispatching the equipment and manpower.
 The Village of Lang is responsible for the insurance.
 The Village of Lang is responsible for training the fire fighters.
 The Village of Lang determines priority in case of sumultaneous
- 4. It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall commence on June 12, 1990 and be continuous.

The agreement may be terminated by any party to the agreement giving 60 days notice in writing.
