

BYLAW NO.4-85

VILLAGE OF LANG

A bylaw to classify, regulate and licence any business, trade or calling not assessable for the purposes of business taxation in respect to their business, trade or calling.

The Council of the Village of Lang, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression "transient trader" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Urban Municipality Act.

2. No person shall carry on the business of a transient trader within the village unless he possesses a valid and subsisting licence for that purpose issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.

3. The secretary-treasurer of the Village is hereby authorized to issue a transient traders licence to any person carrying on business in the village:

(a) who offers to provide a service for a price or offers goods or merchandise for sale by retail or by auction, or solicits any person who is not a wholesale or retail dealer for orders for future services for a price or the future delivery of goods or merchandise; and

(b) who is not assessable by the village for the purposes of business taxation in respect of that business; and

(c) who is not required to be licensed under The Direct Sellers Act; and

(d) who makes application for such licence stating specifically the nature of his business in the Village; and

(e) who has complied with The Auctioneers Act if the same applies or may apply in respect of the licence for which he has made application under this bylaw; and

(f) who tenders with his application the proper license fee as herein provided for.

4..Subject to the right of the Council to suspend or revoke the same, as provided by the Village Act every licence issued hereunder shall remain in force and effect until and including the thirty-first day of December of the year of issue.

5. Subject to section 6, the fee payable for a licence under this bylaw shall be as follows: (suggested list of classifications)

(a) For a contractor or subcontractor who offers to provide services in the construction, maintenance, repair or demolition of buildings or other structures-----\$ 50.00

(b) For a person who offers legal, accounting, medical or engineering services-----50.00

(c) For a person who offers barbering or hairdressing or other personal beautification services-----10.00

(d) For a person who offers to provide or takes orders to provide drycleaning, laundry, dyeing or glazing or garment exchange services-----10.00

(e) For a person who offers sharpening services-----10.00

(f) For a person who offers chimney, window, septic tank or any other cleaning services-----10.00

(g) For a person who offers tilling, gardening or landscaping services-----25.00

(h) For a person who offers goods or merchandise for sale (1) by retail only (2) by public auction (3) by both methods } --- \$ 50.00

(i) For a person who offers to provide or takes orders to provide a service other than a service hereinbefore mentioned----- 50.00

(j) For a person who solicits any person who is not a wholesale or retail dealer for orders for the future delivery or goods or merchandise----- 50.00

(k) Who offers electrical contracting service----- 30.00

6. Every licence issued hereunder shall specifically state the kinds of services, goods or merchandise which the licensee is authorized to offer for sale or take order for as the case may be and whether, in the case of goods or merchandise, he may offer the same for sale by retail or by public auction or both. Such licence shall also state the restriction as set forth in section 7 hereof.

7. No person to whom a licence is issued under this bylaw shall offer for sale services, goods or merchandise, or solicit orders for future services or the future delivery of goods or merchandise within the village:

- (a) other than of a kind or kinds described in the licence; or
(b) by any method except as authorized therein; or
(c) at any time or during any period when shops within the village offering for sale or taking orders for similar (1) services or future services (2) goods or merchandise are required by the Village bylaw to be and remain closed.

8. Every person licensed under this bylaw shall, at all reasonable times, upon request of the secretary treasurer, the village constable, or license inspector, or any peace officer, produce such licence for inspection purposes.

9. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties as provided in the general penalty bylaw of the village.
