

BYLAW NO. 6-85

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LANG TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF UNTIDY AND UNSIGHTLY PREMISES

The Council of the Village of Lang enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall come into force on the day of the final passing thereof.
2. The Medical Health Officer, Public Health Inspector and Police Constable are hereby authorized to declare any premises untidy and unsightly.
3. Any of the persons designated in Section 2 may in writing order the owner or occupant of the premises to remedy the untidiness or unsightliness within such time as may be specified in the order, and if the owner or occupant fails to comply with the order the said person shall report the matter to the Council.
4. Upon receipt of such report, the Council may direct that the necessary work be done to remedy the untidiness and unsightliness, but before such work is proceeded with, shall by notice in writing notify the owner or occupant of the premises of its intention and of the estimated cost of doing the work, and that a period of ten days from the date of service of the notice will be allowed for such owner or occupant to appear before the Council and show cause, or otherwise show cause why such work should not be proceeded with.
5. A notice under Section 4 shall be served personally on the owner or occupant.
6. If the owner or occupant does not within the said period of ten days satisfy the Council that the work should not be proceeded with, the Council may proceed to have the work done, and the cost of the work, if not repaid to the village on or before the 31st day of December of the year in which the work is done, shall be added to and form part of the taxes on the land constituting the premises.
