BYLAW 6/97

**ESTABLISHING AND OPERATING
A REGIONAL LIBRARY.**

Whereas the municipality of the Village of Lang, together with the municipalities listed on the attached schedule, pursuant to THE PUBLIC LIBRARIES ACT, 1996, have associated themselves each with the others in establishing and operating a regional library to be known as

THE SOUTHEAST REGIONAL LIBRARY

And Whereas the terms of such association to be performed by each of the said municipalities have been set out in an agreement attached as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw and have been confirmed by bylaw of each of the said municipalities;

And Whereas the said agreement provides for the admission of other municipalities for the said purpose and under the same said terms:

NOW THEREFORE the council of the VILLAGE OF LANG in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the Regional Library Bylaw
2. It shall be lawful for the Village of Lang to enter into the said agreement with the said associate municipalities and with such other municipalities as have been or may be admitted as associated municipalities for the said purpose which agreement is incorporated as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw and form part hereof.
3. The Mayor and Administrator are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to execute the said agreement on behalf of the Village of Lang and to attach the Corporate Seal of the Village of Lang thereto and to do or cause to be done all acts, matters and things which may be necessary for the due performance and fulfillment of the terms of the said agreement.
4. The Bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of the final passing thereof.
